Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how ScaleOut Software, Inc. ("we", "us") collects, uses, and protects the user's ("your") personal information when you use our platform, the ScaleOut Active Caching Management UI (the "Service"). We are committed to safeguarding your privacy and ensuring the security of your personal data.

Your Consent

Please read this Privacy Policy in its entirety. By accessing or using the Service, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with any of the terms, please do not use the Service.

Data We Collect

Contact Data

As part of the process of installing and using the Service, we collect certain personal information, including your email address, full name, and company name ("Contact Data"). We collect this data when you fill out a form on our website (scaleoutsoftware.com) or when you contact us.

Usage Data

We do not collect any other data from your usage of the platform, including files you upload, account settings, or telemetry data (collectively, "Usage Data"), unless you explicitly provide this information to us, e.g. in a support email. All information provided in a support context is subject to the terms of our Support Agreement.

For on-premises deployments of the Service, Usage Data is stored locally. For cloud deployments of our Service, Usage Data including user accounts, deployments, and data storage is managed between you and Microsoft Azure, and is subject to their privacy

policies. Optional connections you create within the Service may transfer Usage Data to third party service providers (see "Sharing Information with Third Parties" below).

Legal Basis for Data Use

We collect and/or process your Contact Data and Usage Data based on at least one of the following grounds:

- We need to perform a contract with you.
- You have given us permission to do so.
- Processing your personal information is in our legitimate interests.
- We need to comply with applicable legal obligations.

How We Use Your Data

We may use your Contact Data and Usage Data for the following purposes:

- To operate, maintain, and improve the Service and our business operations.
- To send you updates, notices, announcements, and other information related to the Service.
- To communicate with you regarding technical support, feedback, complaints, and to manage our engagement with you.
- To detect, prevent, and investigate fraud, security breaches, and other illegal activities, including breaches of this Privacy Policy or our Terms of Service.
- To comply with applicable laws and regulations, and to respond to legal proceedings involving us or our affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

Our Service allows you to connect to third-party service providers who help us enhance and provide our Service. These providers may include, but are not limited to:

- Connectors: Azure IoT Hub, Azure Kafka.
- Account Management: Azure B2C.
- Mapping Services: ArcGIS.
- Generative Al: OpenAl.

Certain third-party services may require credentials such as API keys or database connection strings. We do not have access to these credentials when you provide them through the Service.

Please note that we are not responsible for any processing of Contact Data or Usage Data by these third parties. If you connect to them and/or share data with them through our Service, their respective privacy policies will apply.

Disclosure of Your Data

We may disclose your Contact Data and Usage Data in the following circumstances:

- **Vendors and Service Providers:** We may share your data with third-party vendors and service providers as necessary to provide the Service.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a strategic transaction, such as a merger, acquisition, reorganization, or bankruptcy, your data may be shared with counterparties and transferred to a successor as part of the transaction.
- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose data in response to legal obligations such as subpoenas, search warrants, or court orders, or in connection with investigations into suspected illegal activity, fraud, or other wrongdoing.

Data Retention

We will retain your Contact Data and Usage Data only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy or for other legitimate business reasons, such as resolving disputes, ensuring safety and security, or complying with legal obligations.

Minors

Our Service is not intended for individuals under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect Contact Data or Usage Data from children under 18. We will investigate the matter and delete the data if appropriate.

Data Security

We implement reasonable technical, administrative, and organizational measures to protect your Contact Data and Usage Data from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or
